INTRODUCTION

What is sin?

1. It is an act. Transgression of the law (written or in the conscience).
2. It is a state. The absence of righteousness.
3. It is a nature. Enmity toward God.

1) ORIGINAL SIN (Gen.2:15-17, 3:1-7; Rom.5:12-19).

2) THE TOTAL DEPRAVITY OF MAN (Jer.13:23; Rom.1:18-32).

3) DEAD IN SIN (Eph.2:1-3; John 5:24; Rom.6:23).

4) THE SLAVERY OF SIN (Rom.6:15-16).

APPLICATION

- 1) Have you been made free from the depravity, death, and slavery of sin?
-*Sin causes death but Christ is the resurrection* (1 Cor.15:20-26).
-*Sin produces slavery but Christ makes us free* (Rom.6:5-7; 14-22).
