Psalm 2:6:

“Yet I have set My King
On My holy hill of Zion.”

I. CHRIST’S KINGSHIP IS PREDICTED & PREFIGURED

(Gen.49:9,10; Psalm 2:6; Psa.45:6,7; Micah 5:2; Jer.23:5,6).

- (a) The King will come through the tribe of Judah (Gen. 49:9-10).
- (b) A Holy King to reign over a holy kingdom is prophesied (Psalm 2:7).
- (c) Christ’s eternal throne predicted (Psalm 45:6-7).
- (d) The King will be born in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2).
- (f) Christ’s reign prefigured in David (Jer.23:5,6).

2. CHRIST’S KINGLY ATTRIBUTES

- (a) The coming King will be lowly (Zech.9:9; Isa.53:3; Matt.11:29; Phil.2:5-8).
- (b) Eternal King (1 Tim.1:17).
- (c) King of Righteousness (Heb.7:2a).
- (d) King of Peace (Heb.7:2b).

3. CHRIST’S KINGDOM NOT OF THIS WORLD (John 6:16; 18:36).

-The manner of our Lord’s coming was not in the royal splendor of this world, but in humility.

4. CHRIST’S KINGSHIP MOST BEAUTIFULLY SEEN ON THE CROSS (Matt.27:11,29; Luke 23:34-38).

5. THE GLORY AND SPLENDOR AS KING (1 Tim.6:15b-16; Rev.5:8-14; Rev.19:11-16).

1. Have you submitted your life to Jesus Christ and King and Lord of your life?
2. If you have, does the Lord reign and control every area of your life?
