9 Joseph, Part 9

Gen. 45:1-15

SCRIPTURE READING

INTRODUCTION

Joseph is a type of Christ because:

- 1) Joseph's brothers dwelt in a land wherein was no corn (Gen. 42:5,2).
- 2) Joseph's brothers wished to pay for what they received (Gen. 42:5).
- 3) Joseph's brothers assume a self-righteous attitude as they come before the Governor of Egypt (Gen 42:7-11).
- 4) Joseph's brothers were cast into prison for three days (Gen 42:17).
- 5) Joseph's brothers were now smitten in their conscience (Gen. 42:18-21).
- 6) Joseph makes it known that deliverance is by grace (Gen. 42:25).

- 7) Joseph's brothers now enjoy a brief respite (Gen. 42:26).

- 8) Joseph's brothers soon had their superficial peace disturbed (Gen. 42:27-28).

- 9) Joseph's brothers continued to manifest a legal spirit (Gen. 43:11,15).

- 10) Joseph's brothers are now made happy again (Gen. 43:33-34).

- 11) Joseph is determined to bring his brothers out into the fight (Gen. 44:1-2).

- 12) Joseph's brothers, at last, take their true place before God (Gen. 44:4,16).

- 13) Joseph made himself known to his brothers (Gen. 45:1).

- 14) Joseph invites his brothers to come near to him (Gen. 45:4,7).

- 15) Joseph gives proof that he is fully reconciled to his brothers (Gen. 45:15).
